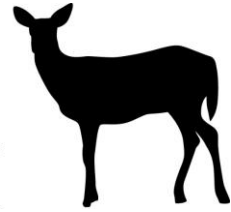

Health & Safety

- For your own safety and well being we ask you to please keep to the footpaths and roadways.
- Children should be supervised at all times whilst on the decking and in the hot tub.
- Please take care when on the decking, especially when it is wet as it can become slippery.
- For your safety, please only use the plastic glasses provided when in or around the hot tub area.
- Please close and fasten the hot tub lid when it is not in use as this can reduce the temperature of the hot tub & will take longer to warm up again.
- All household rubbish should be disposed of in the Bin & Recycling Area located at the Park entrance. Please do not leave rubbish bags outside of your lodge as this may attract scavengers.
- Barbeques are strictly forbidden on the lodge decking without the use of a BBQ stand. **These are available to hire.** Please visit the reception for details.
- Smoking is not permitted inside the lodge. When smoking on the decking, please use the ashtray provided and make sure cigarettes/cigars are extinguished fully as we are in a woodland area.
- In the event of a fire the **Fire Assembly Point** is located near the **Bin & Recycling Area** at the park entrance.
- We have experienced power cuts in the past when the weather has been stormy; therefore, the lodges are equipped with **battery powered lanterns**, which can be found in the **cupboard under the sink**. Spare batteries can be found in the kitchen drawers.
