#### **The Avenues, Hull, HU5 (Approx 7 Miles)**

Away from the hustle and bustle of Hull city centre lies a neighbourhood that has been proudly doing its own thing for many a year now: The Avenues. Named after the tree-lined residential streets that run east-west between Princes "Prinny" Avenue and Chanterlands "Chants" Avenue, it's also come to refer to Princes Avenue itself and Newland Avenue, just north of Princes Avenue. The Avenues is a thriving, cosmopolitan neighbourhood, close to the University of Hull, with more than 30 restaurants and bars. It also has scores of independent cafés and traders that regularly tempt people away from the city centre.
